


### Application for admission to JC/MI/Polytechnic/ITE

- Information required for registration:
  - Singpass or the JAE PIN (found in the hard copy Form A)
  - Form A [list the applicant's GCE O-Level exam results, eligible courses under the JAE, and JAE PIN (i.e. a personal password for access JAE-IS)].
- Complete the JAE worksheet (in Form A or the JAE information booklet) before submitting their online application.










### **Direct School Admission to JC**

 Students who do not meet the JC admission criteria may take part in the JAE to apply for courses which they are eligible for.





### How can I maximise my 12 choices?

### The 3 Ps of making choices in JAE

#### PASSION PRACTICALITY PRUDENCE

Fill up all 12 choices even if you are really confident of getting into your desired course.

(You never know what the competition is like for this year. If the cut-off point drops and/or the course is more competitive this year, you may not be given a space. By leaving blanks, you are effectively not giving yourself a chance and hence become unposted with nowhere to go if you are not given any of your choices, supposing you only fill up 4 choices.)



#### **JAE Tips**

#### How can I maximise my 12 choices?

Adapted from NP Admission Tips

First 3 – 4 choices

#### **PASSION**

Go for what you are most passionate about (even if you don't meet the past year's cut-off points). (Your 1st choice is important especially if you want to appeal in the event you do not get posted there. This is so long as you meet the cut-off point.)

Next 3 – 4 choices

#### **PRACTICALITY**

Choose what you are interested in and stand a good chance of getting in.

Last few choices

#### **PRUDENCE**

Include <u>alternative</u> / less competitive courses you can definitely get in.




