

- Upon release of the GCE O-Level results in January 2021, all **PFP-eligible** students may submit an application online via the PFP portal at <https://pfp.polytechnic.edu.sg/PFP/index.html>.
- The application window for PFP will open at 2.00 pm on the day the GCE O-Level results are released (Day 1) and will remain open for five days thereafter (at 4.00 pm on Day 5 as the last day for application).

- The final application phase for the **DPP** will open on Monday, 11 January 2021 and close on Friday, 15 January 2021.
- The DPP posting results for applications made under the final application phase will be released at 9.00am on Tuesday, 19 January 2021 through the DPP application portal. Students will be required to indicate whether they wish to accept or reject the DPP offer by Thursday, 21 January 2021.

❑ Applicants posted to Junior Colleges or Millennia Institute:

- **You must report to the JC or MI at 7.30am on Friday, 29 January 2021** following the release of the JAE posting results. If not, your place will be forfeited. It will then be made available to other eligible applicants appealing for a place in the course.

❑ For applicants posted to polytechnics and ITE, they will receive a letter from the respective institutions on the enrolment details.

- Students who had accepted offers through the 2020 Direct School Admission – Junior Colleges (DSA-JC) Exercise are deemed to be admitted to their chosen JC if they have met the eligibility criteria for admission to JC based on their GCE O-Level examination results.

- Students who had accepted conditional offers to a polytechnic course through the Early Admissions Exercise (EAE) in 2020 and have their offers confirmed based on their GCE O-Level examination results will not be eligible to participate in JAE.

- Their EAE offers are confirmed if they meet the following criteria:
  - a. A net ELR2B2 score of 26 points or better for the GCE O-Level examinations; and
  - b. Minimum Entry Requirements for the respective polytechnic course.

- The last day of school for Secondary 5 students who have accepted a place in the PFP will be on the last Friday of Jan, 29 January 2021.
- Students will be informed by the respective polytechnics on the dates of enrolment for the PFP.

## **First period**

Between the 1st to 5th working day from the date of release of the GCE O-Level Examination results.

## **Second period**

Between the 1st to 5th working day from the date of release of the JAE posting results.

# How can I maximise my 12 choices?

## The 3 Ps of making choices in JAE

**PASSION**  
**PRACTICALITY**  
**PRUDENCE**

*Fill up all 12 choices even if you are really confident of getting into your desired course.*

(You never know what the competition is like for this year. If the cut-off point drops and/or the course is more competitive this year, you may not be given a space. By leaving blanks, you are effectively not giving yourself a chance and hence become unposted with nowhere to go if you are not given any of your choices, supposing you only fill up 4 choices.)

# JAE Tips

## *How can I maximise my 12 choices?*



First 3 – 4 choices	<b>PASSION</b> Go for what you are most passionate about (even if you don't meet the past year's cut-off points). <i>(Your 1<sup>st</sup> choice is important especially if you want to appeal in the event you do not get posted there. This is so long as you meet the cut-off point.)</i>
Next 3 – 4 choices	<b>PRACTICALITY</b> Choose what you are interested in and stand a good chance of getting in.
Last few choices	<b>PRUDENCE</b> Include <u><i>alternative</i></u> / less competitive courses you can definitely get in.


