

 - **Form A** [list the applicant's *GCE O-Level exam results*, *eligible courses under the JAE*, and *JAE PIN* (i.e. a personal password for access JAE-IS)].
- **Complete the JAE worksheet** (in Form A or the JAE information booklet) **before submitting their online application.**

Direct School Admission to JC

Participation in JAE for DSA-JC Students

- Students admitted to a JC through DSA-JC* **will not be eligible to participate** in the JAE .
- Students who **do not meet the JC admission criteria may take part in the JAE** to apply for courses which they are eligible for.

*accepted DSA offer and met the eligibility criteria for admission to the chosen JC



Early Admission Exercise to Poly

Participation in JAE for EAE/Poly Students

- Students with confirmed offers from Poly EAE* **will not be eligible to participate** in the JAE .
- Students who **do not meet** the criteria of Poly EAE* **will get another chance to apply for polytechnic via JAE**

*Criteria for Poly EAE:

- Net ELR2B2 of 26 points or better and
- Minimum entry requirements for the respective polytechnic courses

PFP applicants

- Students who **accepted** a place in earlier application of **DPP in Dec 2022** and **decide to take up PFP offer**:

1. Apply to ITE to **withdraw from DPP first**, then
2. Able to take up PFP offer

- For current Sec 5 students who have accepted a place in PFP
 - Last day of school in KCPSS – **27 Jan 2023 (Friday)**
 - Respective polys will inform on the enrolment dates for PFP

- Students who are **newly eligible for DPP** (with inclusion of O level subjects grades)
 - Submit application online via DPP application portal (www.ite.edu.sg/apply-for-ite-courses)

How can I maximise my 12 choices?

The 3 Ps of making choices in JAE

PASSION
PRACTICALITY
PRUDENCE

Fill up all 12 choices even if you are really confident of getting into your desired course.

(You never know what the competition is like for this year. If the cut-off point drops and/or the course is more competitive this year, you may not be given a space. By leaving blanks, you are effectively not giving yourself a chance and hence become unposted with nowhere to go if you are not given any of your choices, supposing you only fill up 4 choices.)

JAE Tips

How can I maximise my 12 choices?

Adapted from NP Admission Tips

First 3 – 4 choices	PASSION Go for what you are most passionate about (even if you don't meet the past year's cut-off points). <i>(Your 1st choice is important especially if you want to appeal in the event you do not get posted there. This is so long as you meet the cut-off point.)</i>
Next 3 – 4 choices	PRACTICALITY Choose what you are interested in and stand a good chance of getting in.
Last few choices	PRUDENCE Include <i>alternative</i> / less competitive courses you can definitely get in.

What you can do before getting results and after getting them

- Consider various scenarios – best and worst case

- Do your research into all possibilities from different JCs to various Poly courses
- Factors to take into consideration:
 - Interest in the school/course – why? How does that fit you, your interest, education goals?
 - School culture – what the learning environment is like
 - Distance – how much time are you willing to travel each day to and from school?
